ONLINE WORKSHOP – 18 JUNE, 2020: INCREASING TERRITORIAL RESILIENCE IN THE MEDITERRANEAN REGION THROUGH LOCAL SOLUTIONS AND YOUTH EMPOWERMENT

This two-session live workshop will aim to promote a new generation of climate leaders to strengthen the resilience of communities and territories to climate change, migration, and pandemics. Climate experts and Mediterranean youth leaders will be engaged to explore local level solutions and share their inspiring practices.

The first session will feature initiatives by youth leaders, from the Mediterranean region, presenting their solutions to increasing the resilience of communities to climate change and global pandemics. The aim is to create an interactive space for youth voices to share visions, approaches, experiences and innovative practices. Through this joint undertaking, the workshop will promote the creation of a youth territorial resilience and climate change Community of Practice.

During the second session, senior climate experts will showcase inspiring practices and solutions to climate change and migration nexus, aimed at providing decision-makers and youth actionable solutions on these two key global change concerns. The workshop will cover local climate resilience strategies for in/out migrants on food security, water system management, land management, energy and others.
