### Online Meeting, 29 September 2020

---

This event will build on CMI's 2020 '*Mediterranean Youth Climate Heroes Contest*' and June 18, 2020 online workshop on '*Achieving Territorial Resilience through Youth Empowerment*'. The meeting's main objective is to launch and engage a community of young practitioners on territorial resilience to climate change: the Mediterranean Youth for Climate Action network or MedYCA. The selected youth invited to the event will participate in a community building game and start organizing themselves as a community of practice.

CMI team will present the objectives and next steps of their youth program and the youth community of practice. This online workshop will be followed by a series of three online workshops in Oct., Nov. and Dec. whose main objective is to have the youth prepare a set of policy recommendations to be presented at 2021 Global Youth Forum during the International Union for Conservation of Nature (IUCN) World Conservation Congress.

During this online meeting, the youth will be invited to participate in a community building world climate game. With the support of Cli'Mates team, an international youth-led think-and-do tank on climate change, the youth will put themselves in the shoes of key players in international climate negotiations who negotiate a treaty. This team building game will help promote the creation and engagement of MedYCA.
